The Texas Legislature has mandated that a course repeated by a student more than twice at a public institution of higher education may not be reported for state funding. As a result, the institution must either pass the non-funded portion to all students or charge a supplementary fee to the student who is repeating the course. Consequently, Panola College has chosen to assess a supplementary fee to only those students repeating the course more than twice, beginning with the Fall 2006 semester. Courses in Developmental Studies and English as a Second Language (ESL) are not affected by the supplementary fee. For a course being "three-peated" (being taken for a third time), students will be charged \$75 per semester credit hour (\$225 for a 3 hour course) <b>in addition</b> to tuition and required fees associated with the course.
